FAR Therapeutic Arts and Recreation, "FAR" adheres to the richest ideals of personal responsibility, sportsmanship, and training and competition in all of its activities and pursuits.

I understand that my participation in activities with FAR is a call to excellence for me to participate, train and/or compete in ways that bring honor to me, to my family, and to my team (if applicable). I pledge to uphold the spirit of this Code of Conduct, which is only a general guide for my conduct and does not describe all types of good behavior and bad behavior. If I do not obey this Code of Conduct, FAR may suspend me from participation, either temporarily or permanently. If I am suspended from participating, I can appeal the decision in accordance with the attached Grievance Process.

I pledge that:

- I will try hard to do my best.
- I will not use bad language, such as swearing or insulting other persons, and will not fight with other participants, athletes, coaches, volunteers or staff.
- I will learn and follow the rules of my activity or sport, and I will ask questions when I do not understand.
- I will not make unwanted physical, verbal or sexual advances on others.
- I will report any such advances made to me to FAR staff or my parents.
- I will not drink alcohol, smoke tobacco or use illegal drugs at FAR venue sites, and I will not take drugs for the sake of improving my performance.
- I will obey all laws and competition rules.

By signing below, I agree that I have read, or have had read to me, and understand this Code of Conduct and that I agree to obey it. If I violate this Code of Conduct and disagree with the consequence, I agree to follow the attached FAR Grievance Process and I will accept the decision as final.
