This camp is for special needs campers and their sibling(s) ages 3-16 and runs July 30th-August 10th from 9:00 - 11:30 a.m. each day. To cap off all our time together, we will have a public performance on the last day of camp for friends and family to enjoy.

Your child(ren) will be placed in a group according to age and ability and will rotate among fun-filled therapeutic sessions including art, music, recreation, and movement. Camper groups are assigned counselors who rotate with the group to each session. Please note that if your child(ren) requires one on one assistance, it must be provided by the family. A short interview is required to determine placement for all new campers prior to the start of camp.
